The Campus Director as team captain harmonizing the web of significantly functioning offices and services achieving the Pisay mandate.

The Campus Director, Ruwina S. Gonzaga opens her office to all services and dealings of the school.

Instruction. The Director is a teacher by passion. She allots time to sit with students for her to see, listen, and experience firsthand the learning process they undergo, so to identify the needs and the areas where which the teaching-learning process can improve. The Director's Time every Monday morning is celebrated with a hearty talk on the value of the week.


